




One of major project proposal in Rajasthan, Khushkheda-Bhiwadi-Neemrana Investment Region (KBNIR) is estimate to have investments worth Rs 27,371 cr and create 5 lakh jobs. Chief Minister VasunDelhi - Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC) is India's most ambitious Infrastructure programme aiming to develop new industrial cities as "Smart Cities" and converging next generation technologies across

The objective is to expand India's manufacturing and services base and develop DMIC as a "Global Manufacturing and Trading Hub". The programme will provide a major impetus to planned urbanization in India with manufacturing as the key driver. In the first phase seven new industrial cities are being developed.

Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor



Rajasthan touches six major States of the Northern, Western and Central India. The State is a natural corridor between the wealthy northern and the prosperous western states of the country, which makes it an important trade and commerce centre.

Dedicated Freight Corridor (DFC) a 1,483 km long rail corridor connecting Jawaharlal Nehru Port near Mumbai to Dadri near Delhi will allow high-speed connectivity for high axle load wagons (25 tonnes) of double stacked container trains supported by high power locomotives. A band of 150 km on both sides of the DFC has been chosen to be developed as the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC).




Apart from the usual industrial areas, the Export Promotion Industrial Park (EPIP) and the Japanese Zone in Majarkanth is particularly noteworthy.

The Chauhan capital was shifted from Mandhan (near Alwar) to Neemrana when the fort was established by Raja Dup Raj in 1467. Nowadays, the Neemrana fort is a heritage resort.



Built from 1464 AD, Neemrana Fort-Palace is located on a high hillock and commands magnificent views of the surrounding beauty.

It is among India's oldest heritage resort hotels, as it was created in 1986 . Its name derives from a valiant local chieftain named Nimola Meo.

Khushkhera-Bhiwadi-Neemrana Investment Region, in North-Eastern Rajasthan, would be located within 50km from the alignment of Dedicated Freight Corridor. This region also falls under the National Capital Region of Delhi and is located close to the National Highway No.8 which forms part of the Golden Quadrilateral. Government of Rajasthan has set out ambitious plans for the region by developing a Global City, to be spread over 40,000 Acres, between Shahjahanpur, Neemrana and Behror and expected to cater to 1 Million Population. Detailed master planning is being carried out for the project.

Delhi International Airport will offer good connectivity to the proposed investment region. Besides, an independent airport complex is also proposed to be developed.

State Government has already identified and designated the land for developing the region as Global City.



The Big Govt. approved projects like: DMIC, Airport, DELHI METRO from Delhi to ALWAR in 90 minutes, besides Industrial Ventures by JAPAN & KOREA has already been stated production of Korean will also expected in 2 years.

Khushkhera-Bhiwadi-Neemrana Investment Region is located at a distance of 107km from Delhi.

Widening of Alwar-Dausa Link (81km) is being carried out by RIDCOR through private sector participation.

Availability of huge Land parcels of land at comparatively lower prices.

Potential industry sectors at the investment region include automobile, Biotechnology, IT/ITES and Health Sector.

Proximity to the Golden Quadrilateral, NH-8 and the Dedicated Freight Corridor would provide added value to the investors in the region.



Industrial Scenario:

Industrial Hub Bhiwadi

Khushkhera - Bhiwadi - Neemrana (KBN) has been identified as the priority Investment Region in Rajasthan sub-region of DMIC in consultation with the state government for achieving the envisaged goals and objectives of DMIC Project.

Bhiwadi Complex comprises of 99 revenue villages spreads over an area of about 250 Sq. Km. Bhiwadi, Tapookara, Chaupanki, Kahrani and Khushkhera are major industrial nodes in the Complex.RIICO has laid extensive road network (127 kms) and drainage network (160 kms) in its industrial areas. Further roads and drains are under construction in newly established industrial areas.

Industries in Greater Bhiwadi Complex are of varied scale and nature. There are number of large, medium and small scale industries. Auto Parts, Ceramics, Chemical, Drugs and Pharmaceutical, Electronics, Food Products, General Engineering, Glass, Iron & Steel, Metals, Bathroom Fittings, Plastic, Packaging, Rubber, Leather, Textile related industries are concentrated in Bhiwadi, Khushkhera and Chaupanki industrial areas




At present a total of 6,550 acres is under industrial development within Greater Bhiwadi Complex distributed in eight industrial areas In addition to RIICO industrial areas, industries are developed along Bhiwadi-Alwar Road also.

Pathredi industrial area has developed intothree major zones, one for auto and engineering, 2nd for cable and 3rd for garment sector.

There are three main Electric Substations, GSS of 220 KVA of 200 MVA capacity and GSS 132 KVA of 100 MVA capacity at Bhiwadi, GSS of 400 KVA of Power Grid in Bhiwadi.

A plan to construct a cargo airport near Neemrana is also u n d e r consideration. This airport is proposed to be constructed in the middle of Ajarka and Kotkasim.

Situated in ALWAR district, the area was transferred to RIICO in 2006. The area is well developed with quality infrastructural facilities like good road network of all the roads of National Highway, State Highway and district roads (NH-8), water supply through tubewell, electricity from 220 KV GSS at NIC(M) Neemrana, 132 KV GSS Behror and Shajahanpur, 33/11 KV SS at Industrial Area Neemrana, Behror, NIC(M), Neemrana, etc. Deposits of limestone at Kotputli. Cheap labour force and skilled manpower is avaialable in the area.





RIICO has undertaken social responsibility in this industrial area by transferring village amenity fund and constructing rain water harvesting structure.

RIICO has acquired and developed 210.51 acres of land in which 225 No. of plots have been planned covering an area of 132.67 acres.

The Industrial Area is easily accessible through all modes of transport: nearest railway station is Bawal at a distance of 28 Kms. from the area by road, nearest bus stand Neemrana mod is at a distance of 3 Kms. by road and nearest airport New Delhi is at a distance of 125 Kms. by road from the area. Nearest city Behror is at a distance of 10 Kms. from the area. Concerned administrative headquarter is at a distance of 75 Kms. from the area.

Rajasthan has the second largest network of National Highways in the country with a total road length exceeding 7,000 km.

National Highways provide excellent connectivity to cities like Delhi, Ahmedabad, Vadodara, Mumbai, Jabalpur, Bhopal, Agra, Gwalior, Indore and Amritsar. The total road length in the State is 1,92,551 km (31st March, 2013)

The length of railway routes in the State was 5,784.16 km (March, 2011). These connects
Rajasthan to all major cities in India and links the State to ports in Mumbai, Kandla and Mundra in Gujarat

The State has a fully operational international airport at Jaipur, with direct flights to Sharjah and Muscat. Rajasthan has airports at Jodhpur, Udaipur and airstrips in other major cities.

An Air-Cargo Complex at Jaipur, and Inland Container Depots at Jaipur (2), Jodhpur (3), Bhilwara & Bhiwadi facilitate trade within and outside India.

Excellent mobile networks are operational throughout the State with all major operatorslike Airtel, BSNL, Reliance, Docomo, Idea, Aircel, Vodafone and MTS providing service.

Rajasthan had nearly 46.57 million wirelesssubscribers and 1.08 million wireline subscribers (December 2012).

The State Government has systematically created a policy environment that nurtures private enterprise and makes investing in the State profitable. In addition to a general package of financial incentives, sector-specific policies have been formulated to promote investment.

Rajasthan Investment Promotion Scheme (RIPS), 2010

RIPS 2010 is a package of financial incentives and subsidies for investors. The scheme aims to stimulate private sector investments for employment generation and overall development.

The tracks would cover a distance of 90 km between Delhi and Meerut in 63 minutes, Delhi and Alwar (188 km) in 117 minutes and Delhi and Panipat (109 km) in 61 minutes.

This will be the first phase of the RRTS that is expected to become would be connected linking 16 towns with Delhi.



Japanese Zone

(Neenrana)

The Japanese zone spreads over around 1200 acres and expected investment by Japanese Companies is Rs. 3000 Crore.

As of March, 2011, 59 projects were under implementation with Japanese loan assistance amount committed was about Rs 58,000 crore.

A unit of the world's largest steel making company – Nippon Steel – is also under construction in Neemrana where more than Rs 300 crores is expected to be invested.

Rajasthan Industrial Development and Investment Corporation (RIICO) will set up Ceramic and Glass hub in 250 hectares at Gilot in the industrial area of Neemrana, bordering DMIC, with piped natural gas Export Promotion Industrial Park (EPIP)

Korean Zone

(Neemrana)



An MOU to formalize an agreement to set up the zone was signed between The Rajasthan State Industrial Development and Investment Corporation (RIICO) and South Korean Trade Promotion Agency (Kotra) on March 11, 2013

Setting up of the zone is a step ahead in the mutually beneficial economic cooperation and trade between South Korea and India had already reached 19 billion US dollars last year. The exclusive Korean Zone covering approximately 250 acres is being set up at Ghilot in Neemrana, which is a fast developing industrial area in the NCR.

Cargo Airport (Neemrana)

The new aerotropolis that will be spread over 24 sq kilometers or 2,400 hectares of land is expected to further quicken pace of expansion and growth in this area as well as become a gateway to the tourist destinations of Rajasthan.
